1. Nothing at all after your payment is processed
2. Fake tracking numbers with no actual shipment

1. Complete website URL including all pages and subdomains

3. Email addresses used for communication or order confirmations
4. Phone numbers displayed on the website
5. Payment methods requested and instructions provided
6. Physical address if any is listed on the site
7. Any communication you received from the vendor
8. Bank account, cryptocurrency wallet addresses, or credit card information used
9. Tracking numbers provided even if fake
