What illegal sellers actually deliver:

1. Nothing at all after payment is processed
2. Fake tracking numbers with no actual shipment
3. Counterfeit pills containing fentanyl or other lethal substances
4. Expired medication that has degraded
5. Completely different drugs than what was ordered
6. Empty packages with legitimate looking external labels

The Scam Process of Illegal Roxicodone Sellers

Understanding how these criminal operations work helps you recognize and avoid them. Typical scam workflow:

Information to gather before reporting:

1. Complete website URL including all pages and subdomains

2. Screenshots of no-prescription claims and checkout process
3. Email addresses used for communication or order confirmations
4. Phone numbers displayed on the website
5. Payment methods requested and instructions provided
6. Physical address if any is listed on the site
7. Any communication you received from the vendor
